It's tough to put a price on history, but the new owners of Hamley & Co. have come about as close as anyone.

The store has been operating since 1905, producing one of the finest lines of Western saddles made and supplying cowboys with products across the United States and into several foreign countries.

More recently, the store and the name had begun to fade from its former glory. Enter Blair Woodfield and Parley Pearce, two Idaho cowboys, veterinarians and businessmen, who began picking up the pieces of Hamley's nearly two years ago. The store reopened to rave reviews just prior to the Pendleton Roundup in September.

Every square inch of the three-story structure was restored in preparation for the opening, with heavy emphasis on rich wood tones and melding of old and new concepts.
